Inspector killed, 13 injured as swing collapses at Surajkund Mela

A joyous outing turned into a tragedy at the ongoing Surajkund International Crafts Mela in Faridabad on Saturday when a high-speed swing collapsed, resulting in the death of a police inspector and leaving 13 others injured.

The deceased has been identified as Inspector Jagdish, the swing-in-charge at the fair, who reportedly succumbed to his injuries while undergoing treatment at a hospital. The injured were admitted to a private hospital by ambulance.

According to reports, 18 people were riding the Tsunami swing. As it went up, the swing got stuck, after

which some people were brought down. After this, the swing started moving fast. Then suddenly the swing collapsed. People present at the fair immediately attended to the injured. While rescuing people, a police inspector also got injured, after which an ambulance was called, and all the injured were taken to the hospital. A video of the incident has surfaced, showing the swing falling from top to bottom. After this, people at the fair started running helter-skelter.

After the incident, Faridabad Deputy Commissioner Ayush Sinha reached the spot, and the fairground was evacuated. Sinha said the incident happened at around 6.15 pm when the swing suddenly tilted and

collapsed while people were on it. "A police inspector was declared brought dead. He had tried to save people when the joyride began tilting, but a part of the ride hit him in the face and head. Around 13 people were injured and have been rushed to the hospital. Others are under treatment," Sinha said. Authorities said action will be taken against the joyride operator. "FIR will be registered, and an investigation will be done," the deputy commissioner added.

Raghav, a shopkeeper at the fair, recounted that as people began screaming for help, he climbed the structure and managed to bring down seven or eight passengers safely. However, shortly after he descended, the ride sudden-

ly malfunctioned and crashed to the ground, trapping the remaining occupants.

Inspector Jagdish was reportedly struck by the falling structure while leading the rescue operations on the ground. A video of the horrific incident has surfaced, showing the ride plummeting from its height, leading to a stampede-like situation as panicked visitors fled for safety. Among the identified injured are Rajesh (a constable), Balram, Anuj Kumar, and a woman named Pooja. All victims were rushed to a nearby private hospital via ambulance.

Reacting to the incident, Haryana chief minister Nayab Singh Saini expressed grief over the loss of life. "I am extremely saddened by the

accident that occurred during the Surajkund Mela held in Faridabad. I express deep condolences to the family members of the person who lost their life in this accident," he said. The chief minister further said officials have been instructed to ensure proper and immediate treatment for the injured.

Compounding the tragedy, a welcome arch near Gate Number 2 crumbled moments later, injuring two additional fairgoers caught beneath the debris. Eyewitnesses described scenes of confusion as metal and wood gave way unexpectedly amid throngs of visitors. The Surajkund Mela is one of the largest cultural fairs in the country and attracts thousands of visitors every year.

Government to roll out 500 new electric buses today

The Delhi Government will roll out 500 new electric buses on Capital roads on Sunday, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said after laying the foundation stone for development works worth ₹400 crore in the Matiala constituency in the West Delhi district.

The Chief Minister asserted that Delhi has emerged as the city with the maximum number of electric buses nationwide and said the number of e-buses in the capital will rise to 4,000 after the 500 new vehicles are flagged off on Sunday.

The Delhi Government has set a target to increase the number of e-buses to 11,000, Gupta said, adding that e-buses will be made



available to people in every corner of the city within the next two years.

She said her Government has allocated maximum development funds for Matiala, which is a rural and one of the largest assembly

become a Viksit Delhi," she said. The projects initiated in Matiala are a clear reflection of this approach, where equal attention is being given to infrastructure, civic amenities, cleanliness, and connectivity. "The previous government in Delhi paralysed the rural development board, which has been revived by our government, and projects worth ₹1,700 crore have been sanctioned," the Chief Minister said.

Detailing the projects, the Chief Minister said that the initiatives include strengthen-

ing of roads, drains, drainage systems, parks, community spaces and various civic amenities. Construction of roads connecting rural and urban areas will improve connectivity, making travel easier and giving a boost to the local economy. She expressed confidence that once completed, these works will transform the Matiala Assembly constituency into a strong model of development, convenience and public trust.

She lauded West Delhi MP Kamaljeet Sehrawat and Matiala MLA Sandeep Sehrawat for their efforts towards development works in the area, saying the BJP Government has tried to solve the long-standing problems of Delhi in its first year in power.

MCD commissioner's financial powers enhanced from ₹5 cr to ₹50 cr: Govt

The Delhi Government has enhanced the financial powers of the city's municipal commissioner from ₹5 crore to ₹50 crore, paving the way for faster project approvals. At present, the Municipal Commissioner is empowered to approve projects only up to ₹5 crore.

Projects exceeding this amount required approval from the Standing Committee of the Corporation, followed by final clearance from the House of the Corporation.

This multi-tiered approval mechanism often led to avoidable delays in the execution of development



works. By increasing the Commissioner's financial powers to ₹50 crore, the implementation process of schemes will become simpler, faster, and more effective.

Regarding the decision, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said empowering local bodies for development is the government's top priority. She emphasised that the decision has been taken

with public interest at its core and will directly benefit the people of the capital. Timely execution of development works will ensure better utilisation of resources and enhance the effectiveness of public expenditure, she said.

The enhanced delegation of powers will facilitate the timely execution of works related to roads, drains, sanitation, community facilities, and other essential civic services, it said. It will also help accelerate long-pending projects, reduce procedural bottlenecks, and ensure that development initiatives reach citizens without unnecessary delay, the chief minister's office said in a statement.

Biker death: DJB inquiry finds safety lapses

The Delhi Jal Board's (DJB) internal inquiry into the death of a motorcyclist who fell into a construction pit dug by the agency in west Delhi's Janakpuri area has found several safety and supervisory lapses during the execution of work.

The report also noted that the biker, 25-year-old Kamal Dhyani, was riding against the designated traffic flow, apparently in an attempt to take a shortcut towards his residence, when the incident occurred early Friday.

A day earlier, on the directions of Water Minister Parvash Verma, the DJB had constituted a high-level two-member committee to probe the incident.

It was directed to inspect the accident site and review safety arrangements, barricading, signage, and traffic management and submit its report by the same evening.

"The barricading at the work site was found to be inadequate and improperly



maintained by the agency/contractor. Iron barricades are mandatory along the entire perimeter of the site to ensure comprehensive protection and clear demarcation of the work zone," the report said.

The inquiry revealed that the project site was left unattended at the time of the incident, reflecting a serious lapse in mandatory safety arrangements, officials said.

It was also observed that the road was found closed from both sides and traffic had been diverted to another road, according to findings.

"It is recommended that written show-cause notices be issued without delay to all contractors engaged at the project site. Upon receipt and examination of their replies, strict instructions shall be communicated to the concerned agencies to ensure corrective measures are implemented," the inquiry findings said further.

To prevent recurrence of such incidents, the committee has further recommended strict enforcement of barricading and pit protection norms across all work sites, ensuring full compliance with prescribed standards.

"Mandatory daily monitoring reports are to be submitted by site engineers, documenting safety arrangements and corrective actions taken," the report added further.

Officials suspected of negligence suspended: Sood

Delhi Urban Development Minister Ashish Sood on Saturday said the Government has suspended the officials suspected of negligence in connection with the death of a motorcyclist who fell into a pit dug up for construction work by the Delhi Jal Board (DJB) in west Delhi's Janakpuri area.

After inspecting the site, Sood said a committee was formed immediately after his visit on Friday morning.

The Delhi Government has directed Jal Board engineers to visit all ongoing construction sites and take corrective measures by Saturday evening. "Site visits are ongoing; engineers have been directed to identify shortcomings and take corrective measures by evening at all ongoing construction sites," a senior DJB official said.

"Immediate action was taken under the guidance of the water minister, and after the chief minister's inter-

vention, all officials suspected of negligence have been suspended," Sood said. The minister further added that FIRs have been registered against both the DJB and the contractor involved.

"If any DJB officials are found guilty during the inquiry, cases will be registered against them as well. Legal action is also being

entire case and ensuring timely updates."

Referring to the traffic disruption in the area, Sood said that the construction work on this key road connecting Vikaspuri and adjoining areas would face delays due to the accident. "To minimise inconvenience to residents, we are taking necessary steps to ensure smooth movement of traffic on a single carriageway in both directions," he said.

A joint inspection was conducted by officials from the Delhi Police, the municipal corporation, the DJB and the Public Works Department to expedite the restoration of the road. Sood said the DJB had issued a circular on January 26 directing all departments to ensure compliance with safety norms.

"As the urban development minister, I am also writing to the municipal corporation and other departments. After this incident, we will ensure there are no lapses or negligence is repeated," he said.
